Project Tiger merges with Project Elephant

- Project Tiger and Project Elephant, two significant conservation initiatives in India, have been merged under a new division called 'Project Tiger and Elephant Division' by the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC).
- While the merger aims to rationalize funding and improve conservation by reducing overlap in areas with both programs, the lack of funds and the confusion regarding fund division have raised concerns among experts.
- Recently, the Prime Minister also commended the success of Project Tiger on its 50th anniversary.



Karnataka Leads with Most Billionaire MLAs, Uttar Pradesh Lags Behind: ADR Analysis

- The Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) recently conducted a comprehensive analysis of the assets of MLAs from various political parties in India.
- The report sheds light on the average wealth of MLAs, the percentage of billionaire MLAs, and the representation of women in state assemblies.
- Karnataka emerges as the state with the highest average assets per MLA and the highest number of billionaire MLAs, while Uttar Pradesh lags behind in both categories.

Fiscal Deficit in India Touches 25.3% of Full-Year Target at the End of June 2023: CGA Data

- The fiscal deficit of the Indian government has reached 25.3% of the full-year target at the end of June 2023, as per data released by the Controller General of Accounts (CGA).
- In the previous financial year 2022-23, the fiscal deficit was recorded at 6.4% of the GDP, which was



lower than the earlier estimate of 6.71%. For the current financial year 2023-24, the government aimed to further reduce the fiscal deficit to 5.9% of the GDP.

India to host World Coffee Conference in Bengaluru from Sept 25

- India is set to host the 5th World Coffee Conference (WCC) in Bengaluru from September 25 to 28.
- The International Coffee Organisation (ICO) and the Coffee Board of India will co-organize the event. The central theme of the event will be "Sustainability through Circular Economy and Regenerative Agriculture".
- The event will feature tennis player Rohan Bopanna, who has been appointed as its brand ambassador.



New record of over 6.77 crore Income Tax Returns (ITRs) filed till 31st July, 2023

- The Income-tax Department has witnessed a remarkable surge in the filing of Income Tax Returns (ITRs) for Assessment Year (AY) 2023-24.
- The e-filing portal witnessed a record number of logins during the peak filing period, with over 32 crore successful logins from 1st July 2023 to 31st July 2023. On 31st July 2023 alone, there were 2.74 crore successful logins.
- The department appreciates taxpayers and tax professionals for their timely compliance, leading to a new record of over 6.77 crore ITRs filed till 31st July 2023, representing a significant growth of 16.1% Year-on-Year.

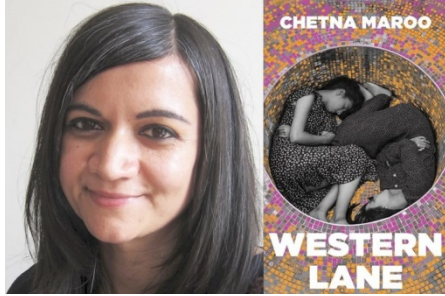
Record-breaking GST Collection in July 2023: Stands at over Rs 1.65 lakh crore

- The Ministry of Finance has released data showing that the gross goods and services tax (GST) collection for July 2023 has surpassed the Rs 1.65 lakh crore mark.
- This marks the fifth instance of GST revenue crossing this threshold since its inception. The revenue for July 2023 is 11 percent higher than the same month last year, reflecting a positive trend in the country's economic growth.

- The total gross GST revenue collected in July 2023 is Rs 1,65,105 crore in which CGST (Central Goods and Services Tax) amounts to Rs 29,773 crore and SGST (State Goods and Services Tax) stands at Rs 37,623 crore.

Indian-origin author Chetna Maroo's debut novel on Booker Prize longlist

- London-based Indian-origin author Chetna Maroo's debut novel 'Western Lane' is among 13 books to make the cut for the 2023 Booker Prize longlist revealed.
- Kenya-born Maroo's novel, set within the context of the British Gujarati milieu, has been praised by the Booker judges for its use of the sport of squash as a metaphor for complex human emotions. It revolves around the story of an 11-year-old girl named Gopi and her bonds with her family.



ISRO injects Chandrayaan-3 into translunar orbit

- The Chandrayaan-3 spacecraft, which marks India's third lunar exploration mission, has accomplished a noteworthy achievement by entering the moon's sphere of influence.
- This successful entry was made possible through a TransLunar Injection (TLI) executed by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).
- ISRO's Telemetry, Tracking, and Command Network (ISTRAC) in Bengaluru has executed the TransLunar Injection (TLI), enabling Chandrayaan-3 to successfully complete its orbits around Earth and begin its journey towards the Moon.



Patna High Court ordered to resume Caste Based Survey in Bihar

- The Patna High Court ordered to resume the caste based survey in Bihar, which was first started

by Patna DM Chandrashekhar himself in Ward 10, Phulwarisharif, Patna.

- The Caste based survey has resumed in entire Bihar, following the order of the Patna High Court. This survey was first started by Patna District Magistrate Chandrashekhar in Ward 10, Phulwarisharif, Patna. There are 13 lakh 69 thousand families in Patna in which 9 lakh 35 thousand people have been surveyed and the survey of the remaining families will be done within a week.

UPI transactions grow 44% to ₹15-lakh crore in July

- The Unified Payments Interface (UPI) network witnessed remarkable growth in July 2023, setting new records in both transaction volume and value.
- After a minor dip in June, UPI transactions surged by 44% year-on-year (YoY) and reached a staggering ₹15.34 lakh crore.
- The number of transactions also hit a new high of 996 crore, a significant increase of 58% compared to July 2022. Market participants predict that UPI transactions will continue to grow, possibly crossing the 1,000-crore mark in the current quarter.

GST Council sticks to its plan to collect 28% tax on online gaming

- The 51st meeting of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council has decided to impose a 28% tax on the full face value of bets placed on online gaming, which will be implemented from 1st October.
- The decision aims to provide clarity on the taxation of supplies in casinos, horse racing, and online gaming.
- The GST Council recommended that the valuation of supply for online gaming and actionable claims in casinos should be based on the amount paid or payable to the supplier by the player, excluding the amount entered into games/bets from previous winnings.



A new book “How Prime Ministers Decide”, by veteran journalist Neerja Chowdhury released

- A new book, titled **How Prime Ministers Decide**, by veteran journalist **Neerja Chowdhury** recalls the drama that led to Sonia’s announcement, prompted by Rahul’s “fear for his mother’s life”.
- This new book also claimed that former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi had good relations with several RSS leaders but carefully kept a distance between the organisation and herself.

One more Cheetah dies at Kuno National Park, taking toll to nine

- A female cheetah named **Dhatri** (Tbilisi) has recently passed away at Kuno National Park in **Madhya Pradesh**. This brings the total number of deaths to **nine**, including **six adult** cheetahs



relocated from Namibia and South Africa, along with **three cubs** born in India, all since March this year.

- Under the ambitious **Project Cheetah**, Kuno National Park is dedicated to reintroducing the cheetah species to the region. To achieve this goal, a total of **20 cheetahs** were brought in from Namibia and South Africa in two distinct batches.
- Currently, there are 14 cheetahs residing in Kuno National Park, consisting of **seven males**, six females, and a female cub.

Why is PM YASASVI Scheme in news?

- The NTA has started the registration procedure of the applicants for the scholarship programme on the NTA’s website by **10th August 2023 under the YASASVI Scheme**. The National Testing Agency (NTA) has started the application procedure for the **scholarship entrance examination 2023** launched under the scheme of PM Young Achievers Scholarship Award Scheme for Vibrant India (YASASVI).
- The NTA invited applications through its official website, **yet.nta.an.in from July 11th, 2023 to August 10th, 2023**. The government has planned to offer **15,000 scholarships** ranging from **Rs.75,000 to**

Rs.1,25,000 per year to class 9-12 meritorious students through the PM YASASVI Scholarship test.

GoI introduces Ayush visa category for foreign nationals seeking medical treatment in India

- **Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA)** introduced a new **Ayush (AY) visa for foreign nationals for treatment under Ayush systems/Indian systems of medicine like therapeutic care, wellness and Yoga**.
- With this, a new chapter i.e. chapter 11A – Ayush Visa has been incorporated after Chapter 11 – Medical visa of the Visa Manual, which deals with treatment under the Indian systems of medicine and accordingly necessary amendments has been made in various chapters of the Visa Manual, 2019.
- AYUSH is an acronym for Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy.

Oil India Upgraded to Maharatna, ONGC Videsh to Navratna by Finance Ministry

- The Finance Ministry of India elevated two major oil sector companies, **Oil India** and **ONGC Videsh**, to the esteemed **Maharatna** and **Navratna** categories, respectively, granting them increased autonomy for investment, joint venture establishment, and other financial decisions.
- Oil India, previously classified as a Navratna company, has now been granted the esteemed Maharatna status, making it the **13th Maharatna CPSE** (Central Public Sector Enterprises) in the country.
- Having obtained a status upgrade to a Navratna CPSE, the company becomes the **14th Navratna CPSE** in the country.



PM Modi to attend BRICS Summit in S. Africa this month

- Indian Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** has confirmed his attendance at the **BRICS Summit** in Johannesburg, **South Africa**, from August 22 to 24, 2023.
- The summit gains significance due to the ongoing crisis in Ukraine and discussions on expanding the

membership of BRICS, a topic of interest to both Russia and China.

- Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be attending the BRICS Summit in Johannesburg from August 22 to 24, 2023.

Government launches Vivad se Vishwas 2.0 scheme for dispute settlement

- The **Department of Expenditure** under the Ministry of Finance has launched **Vivad se Vishwas 2.0** also known as **Contractual Disputes** scheme to settle long-standing contractual disputes involving the government and government undertakings.
- This initiative was announced during the Union Budget 2023-24 by the Union Finance Minister, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman.
- The scheme aims to provide an effective and standardized mechanism for **resolving** contractual disputes, thereby reducing the burden on the legal system and fostering a more **business-friendly environment**.



Govt defers implementation of restrictions on imports of laptops, PCs and tablets to Nov 1

- In a significant late-night decision, the **Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT)** announced the postponement of the licensing mandate for the import of laptops, tablets, and personal computers in India.
- The government had earlier imposed import restrictions on these products due to security concerns and to boost domestic manufacturing.
- However, in light of recent developments, the implementation of the restrictions has been deferred until November 1, 2023.

SBI Posts Highest-Ever Quarterly Profit Of ₹ 16,884 Crore

- **State Bank of India (SBI)**, one of India's largest public sector banks, reported its financial results for the April-June quarter of 2023-24. The bank achieved its **highest-ever quarterly profit** at ₹ 16,884 crore, representing a significant jump from ₹ 6,068 crore in the same period the previous year.

- This remarkable performance was attributed to a **decline in bad loans** and **increased interest income**.
- On a consolidated basis, **SBI's net income** also saw substantial growth, rising more than two-fold to ₹ 18,537 crore compared to ₹ 7,325 crore a year ago.

PModi to Launch ₹24,470 Crore Revamp of 508 Railway Stations under Amrit Bharat Scheme

- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** is set to virtually lay the foundation stone for the redevelopment of 508 railway stations across **India** on August 6. The ambitious project, executed under the **Amrit Bharat Scheme**, aims to enhance passenger amenities and improve **railway infrastructure**.
- With an estimated cost of ₹24,470 crore, the redevelopment work is a significant step towards modernizing the railway system.
- Out of a total of 1,309 stations, 508 have been chosen for the initial phase of redevelopment under the Amrit Bharat Scheme. The ongoing construction work at 24 stations in these states carries a budget of ₹11,136 crore.



Prime Minister launches Amrit Bharat Station Scheme in 13 railway stations

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the **Amrit Bharat Station Scheme (ABSS)** via video link to initiate the rejuvenation of **13** railway stations across the country.
- The Amrit Bharat Station Scheme (ABSS) aims to transform and revitalize **1,309 railway stations** across the nation, enhancing the overall passenger experience and making them world-class travel hubs.
- As part of this initiative, work on 508 stations in various States commenced, with an investment of ₹25,000 crore. In the State, **13 railway stations** will



receive a modern makeover with an investment of ₹303 crore.

Bihar to Constitute 'Rhino Task Force' for Reintroduction of Rhino Conservation Scheme

- The Bihar government to constitute 'Rhino Task Force' for suggesting measures for the reintroduction of rhino conservation scheme in 'Valmiki Tiger Reserve' in West Champaran district.
- The state's wildlife authorities have observed a substantial increase in the tiger population in VTR, prompting them to focus on reviving the rhino population in the region.
- Currently, there is only one rhino in VTR and 14 in Patna Zoo, but with the establishment of the 'Rhino Task Force', the authorities aim to bring back more rhino to the reserve.



HDFC Bank's Jagdishan Highest Paid Bank CEO in FY23 with Rs 10.55cr Pay

- In the fiscal year 2023, Sashidhar Jagdishan, the CEO of HDFC Bank has taken the top spot as the highest paid bank CEO.
- Sashidhar Jagdishan took over as CEO of the HDFC Bank in late 2020 and has shown exceptional leadership during his tenure. His contribution to the bank's growth and profitability has been rewarded with a total remuneration of over Rs.10.55 crore in the FY23 which positions him as the highest-earning bank CEO in the country.
- Among other prominent bank CEOs, Amitabh Chaudhary of Axis Bank ranks high in terms of remuneration. With a payout of Rs.9.75 crore in FY23, he is among the highest-paid bank CEO in the country. Following closely is Sandeep Bakshi of ICICI Bank with the total earning of Rs.9.60 crore for FY23.

World rice price index jumps to near 12-year high in July: FAO report

- As reported by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the FAO All Rice Price Index witnessed a 2.8 percent escalation in July compared to the preceding month, with an average value of 129.7 points. This reflects an approximate 20 percent surge

from the same period in the previous year and marks the most elevated level observed since September 2011.

- In the fiscal year 2022-23, India's exports of non-basmati white rice amounted to USD 4.2 million, a notable increase from the previous year's USD 2.62 million. Noteworthy destinations for India's non-basmati white rice exports encompass the US, Thailand, Italy, Spain, and Sri Lanka.
- The Food and Agriculture Organization serves as a specialized United Nations agency dedicated to spearheading global initiatives aimed at eradicating hunger and enhancing both nutrition and food security.

SC to Appoint All-Woman Panel to Oversee Relief in Manipur

- Chief Justice of India, D.Y. Chandrachud has announced the formation of an all-women panel to help bring healing and relief to the violence-stricken region in Manipur.
- The panel will consist of three former High Court judges, with Justice Gita Mittal as its head. The panel aims to provide healing touch to the situation in Manipur.
- The committee's main task is to oversee relief and rehabilitation efforts, restore homes and places of worship and improve the overall relief work in the violent-affected areas.



Number Of Elephants Goes Up By 346 From Last Count, Touches 6,395 In Karnataka

- According to a report on Asian Elephant population and demography 2023, the state of Karnataka has witnessed a remarkable increase in elephant population.
- The number of elephants in Karnataka has surged from an estimated 6,049 in 2017 to an impressive 6,395, making it the highest elephant-populated region in the country.

Kerala Assembly Approves Resolution to Rename State as 'Keralam'

- In a significant move aimed at embracing its cultural and linguistic heritage, the **Kerala** Legislative Assembly has passed a resolution requesting the Central government to change the name of the state from 'Kerala' to



'**Keralam**'.

- The term 'Keralam' traces its roots to the fusion of two Malayalam words – "Kera," symbolizing **coconut**, and "Alam" denoting **land**. Thus, 'Keralam' intricately encase the essence of the "**Land of Coconut Trees**" paying homage to the state's prolific coconut cultivation, a pivotal contributor amounting to about **45%** of India's overall coconut harvest.
- The proposal involves a modification of the current nomenclature to 'Keralam,' a change that is sought to be instituted through the provisions of **Article 3** of the Constitution. This alteration would encompass the adoption of 'Keralam' as the state's **official name** across all languages listed in the **Eighth Schedule** of the Constitution.

New Amravati Station Becomes Central Railway's Third 'Pink Station'

- Central Railway's New Amravati station has engraved its place in history as



the **first station** in **Bhusaval Division** and

the **third station** within the **Central**

Railway to be designated a "**Pink Station**" – a station that is wholly managed by women staff.

- The New Amravati station boasts a team of **12 proficient women employees**, each playing a crucial role in ensuring the seamless operation of the station. Among these accomplished individuals are **4 Deputy Station Superintendents, 4 Pointswomen, 3 Railway Protection Personnel, and 1 Station Ticket Booking Agent**.

- Ensuring the highest standards of security, ‘SuSwagatam’ offers **role-based secure logins** for different categories of users. During the registration process, individuals have the option to **upload proof of identity** and even capture a live photograph, further enhancing the validation process.

New Bill Proposes Changes in Appointment Process for Election Commissioners in India

- The central government of India has recently introduced a bill in the **Rajya Sabha** that aims to modify the process of appointing the **Chief Election Commissioner** and other **Election Commissioners** of the country. The proposed bill includes significant changes to the composition of the selection committee responsible for these appointments.
- One of the notable changes proposed by the bill is the removal of the **Chief Justice of India** from the selection committee that determines the appointments of the Chief Election Commissioner and other Election Commissioners.
- The bill’s introduction follows a significant ruling by the Supreme Court in March, aimed at ensuring the impartiality and autonomy of the Election Commission. Prior to this ruling, appointments to the Election Commission were made based on the government’s recommendations and were ultimately approved by the President.



The Bharatiya Sakshya Bill, 2023: Revamping India’s Criminal Justice System

- Union Home Minister **Amit Shah** introduced three new bills in **Lok Sabha** to reform the criminal justice system in India. Among these bills is



the **BharatiyaSakshya Bill**, which aims to replace the outdated **Indian Evidence Act of 1872**.

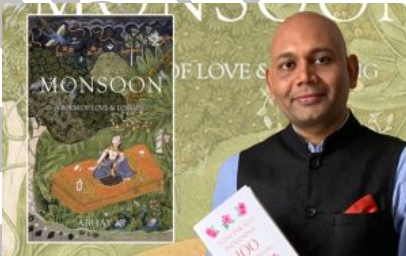
- The **BharatiyaSakshya Bill, 2023**, seeks to consolidate and establish general rules and principles of evidence to ensure a fair trial in criminal cases.
- The current Indian Evidence Act is outdated and lacks provisions that cater to the modern landscape. The new bill aims to rectify this by modernizing the laws surrounding evidence and aligning them with the current needs and aspirations of the populace.

NCLT Approves \$10 Billion Mega-Merger Between Zee and Sony

- The **National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT)** has given the green light to the merger between India's prominent entertainment company, **Zee Entertainment Enterprises**, and **Culver Max Entertainment** (formerly known as Sony Pictures Networks India or SPNI).
- The decision was handed down by the panel led by Justice **HV SubbaRao** alongside member **MadhuSinha**. **SEBI** (Securities and Exchange Board of India) is expected to deliver its **final decision** on the matter on 14th of August.
- The merged entity is poised to reshape the landscape of the **entertainment industry**. The collaborative strength of these two industry titans holds the potential to inaugurate a fresh era of **exceptional entertainment**, captivating audiences and molding the trajectory of India's prominent entertainment realm.

Poet Diplomat Abhay K Launches his New Book 'Monsoon'

- Indian poet diplomat **Abhay Kumar (Abhay K)**, Deputy Director General of Indian Council of Cultural Relations (ICCR), launched his new book titled "**Monsoon: A Poem of Love and Longing**", a booklength poem running across 150 fourline stanzas, at Kathika Culture Centre in Old Delhi, Delhi.
- The book was published by SahityaAkademi on the occasion of its 68th anniversary (13th March 2022). The book is a poem that follows the monsoon which



originates from Madagascar and travels to the Srinagar in the Himalayas and back to Madagascar.

NCERT Constitutes 19-Member Panel for Textbook Revision in India

- The **National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT)** has formed a 19-member committee responsible for aligning school syllabi, textbooks, teaching materials, and learning resources with the **National Curriculum Framework (NCF)**.

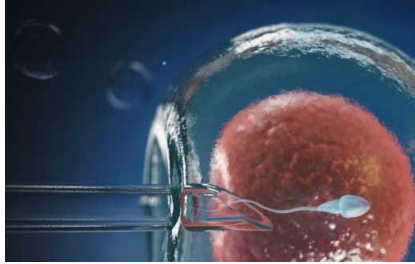

Retail Inflation Surges to 15-Month High of 7.44% in July

- In July, retail



inflation in India experienced a significant upswing, reaching 7.44%, marking the highest rate since April 2022. This surge contrasts with the preceding four-month period of inflation below the central bank's 6% tolerance threshold.

- Vegetable prices surged by a staggering 37.3%, while cereals and pulses became over 13% more expensive. Consequently, urban consumers saw their food bills rise by over 12.3%, while rural consumers experienced an 11% increase in food inflation.
- The **Consumer Price Index (CPI)** rose by 2.9% from the previous month, reflecting the swift inflationary

pressures. The month-on-month increase in food prices was notable as well, with a 6.7% upsurge.

Viacom18 Completes Merger Of JioCinema and Voot OTT Platforms

- Viacom18**, a prominent player in the Indian media and entertainment industry, has made significant strides in merging its two Over-The-Top (OTT) platforms, **JioCinema** and **Voot**.
- The merger has led to the **dissolution of Voot** as a standalone platform, both in terms of functionality and visibility. A simple Google search for Voot **redirects** users to the JioCinema website, consolidating Viacom18's OTT presence under a single brand.
- The merger process gained significant momentum in April 2023, when Viacom18 completed a complex merger scheme involving **Reliance Industries**, Bodhi Tree Systems, and Paramount Global. This strategic move facilitated the **integration of JioCinema** into Viacom18, making it the primary platform for marquee content.



Hyundai Motor To Acquire General Motors' Talegaon Plant

- Hyundai Motor Co's** Indian subsidiary has announced its intention to acquire **General Motors' Talegaon**



plant located in **Maharashtra**.

- Hyundai envisions an extensive upgrade of the Talegaon plant's existing infrastructure as part of its strategic investment. The company plans to **commence manufacturing activities** at the upgraded facility by **2025**
- The acquisition of the Talegaon plant by Hyundai marks an important milestone in General Motors' **exit** from the Indian market. Following a period of declining sales, General Motors **ceased selling cars** in India back in **2017**.

PM Vishwakarma Scheme: Benefits and Eligibility

- The **VishwakarmaYojana** is a visionary initiative by the Indian government designed to extend financial assistance to individuals engaged in traditional crafts and skills. This scheme seeks to provide a strong support system to artisans, enabling them to flourish in their crafts while also contributing to the preservation of India's rich cultural heritage
- Under the umbrella of the VishwakarmaYojana, a dedicated allocation of Rs 13,000 crore has been earmarked to empower artisans across the country. The scheme offers subsidized loans of up to Rs 2 lakh to craftsmen, aiming to alleviate financial constraints that might impede their artistic pursuits.
- Artisans will receive a stipend of Rs 500, enabling them to pursue skill enhancement without financial worries. Additionally, a sum of Rs 1500 will be provided to facilitate the purchase of modern tools, empowering artisans to work with greater efficiency and precision.

India gets first-ever night street racing circuit in Chennai

- The **Tamil Nadu government** and **Racing Promotions Private Limited (RRPL)** have launched a new street circuit in **Chennai**. The 3.5km track will be located around the Island Grounds and will be the first-ever street circuit in India and South Asia to host a night race.
- The track will have elevation changes and 19 corners, including multiple chicanes. It will also offer stunning views of the Marina Beach Road and the Bay of Bengal.
- The event is scheduled to be held on December 9-10 and will feature the F4 Indian Championship and the Indian Racing League. The SDAT will be investing Rs 42 crore to host the event.
- The launch of the new street circuit is a major boost for motorsport in India. It will help to raise the profile of the sport and attract more fans and sponsors. It is also expected to boost tourism in Chennai.



10-day Long Budha Amarnath Yatra Begins In Jammu

- The Jammu and Kashmir administration inaugurated the yearly **Budha Amarnath Yatra** across the rolling terrains of **Poonch district**. The pilgrimage, spanning over a period of 10 days, is a journey of profound significance for devotees seeking blessings from **Lord Shiva**.

India's First 3D-Printed Post Office Inaugurated In Bengaluru

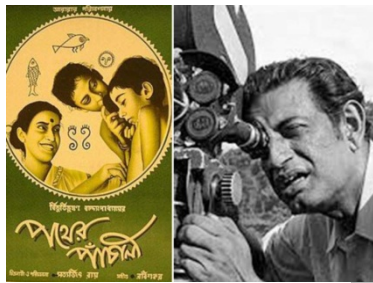

The project, originally slated for completion in September of the previous year, saw its culmination in May 2023 at a cost of **Rs 23 lakh**.

President Droupadi Murmu Grants Assent to Central and Integrated GST Amendment Bills, 2023

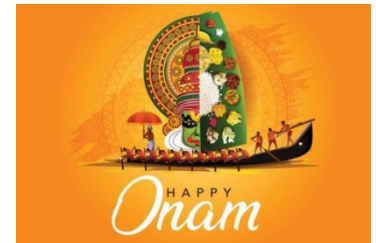

India announces ‘Green’ Hydrogen standard

- **India** has announced the definition of **Green Hydrogen**. The **Green Hydrogen Standard for India** sets a criterion of **2 kg CO2 equivalent per kg H2 as a 12-month average emission threshold**.
- The guidelines established by the **Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE)**, Government of India, delineate the emission benchmarks that must be fulfilled for hydrogen production to qualify as ‘Green’, signifying its origin from renewable sources.
- **Green hydrogen** is a colourless, odourless, tasteless, non-toxic and highly combustible gaseous substance. This form of hydrogen plays a key factor in transitioning towards a carbon-neutral economy while aiding in climate change mitigation.

Onam 2023: History, Significance and Celebrations of Kerala’s Harvesting Festival

- The enchanting festivities of **Onam**, a significant cultural celebration in the state of **Kerala**, have graced the calendar from **August 20 to August 31** this year. - Chandrayaan-3 aims to demonstrate safe and gentle landing, rover mobility, and scientific experiments. A soft landing involves **controlled descent** at a gentle speed to prevent spacecraft damage upon landing.

Chandrayaan-3 vs Lunar-25

- Two remarkable missions – **Lunar 25** and **Chandrayaan-3** undertaken by **Russia** and **India** respectively, epitomize the relentless pursuit of knowledge beyond Earth's boundaries.
- Lunar-25 boasts a liftoff weight of approximately **3,860 lbs (1,750 kg)**, a considerable



portion of which is propellant, essential for its landing and maneuvering on the lunar surface. In comparison, the **Chandrayaan-3 Vikram lander**, weighing **3,862 lbs (1,752 kg)**, includes the 57 lbs (26 kg) Pragyan rover as part of its ensemble.

- Lunar-25's scientific prowess lies in its array of **eight science instruments**, among them the Lunar Manipulator Complex (LMK), designed for excavating lunar regolith. Chandrayaan-3's Vikram lander, on the other hand, is geared to **maximize its operational window** on the Moon's surface. Equipped with **four science payloads**, one of its key objectives involves **inserting a thermal probe** into the lunar soil to a depth of around four inches (10 centimeters).

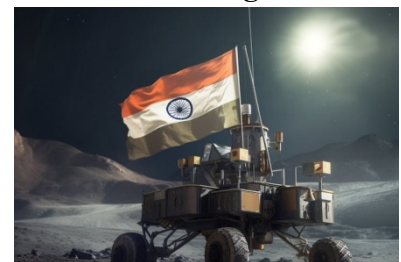


India's First Hydrogen Bus Hits the Public Roads in Leh, Ladakh

- The **Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** has achieved an impressive feat on **YouTube's live streaming platform**. The Chandrayaan-3 Mission Soft-landing **LIVE**



Telecast, broadcasted on August 23, 2023, captured the attention of over **80 lakh peak** concurrent viewers (PCVs), making it the most-watched live stream globally.

- The Chandrayaan-3 Mission took the top spot in terms of peak concurrent viewers, beating the **Brazil vs Croatia football match** from the FIFA World Cup 2022 that had **61 lakh PCVs** and the the Brazil vs South Korea football match from the same tournament with 52 lakh PCVs. ISRO also beat Cariocão 2023 Serie A semi-final between Vasco da Gama and Flamengo with 47 lakh PCVs. The top names in the list include Crew Demo-2 by SpaceX (40 lakh), the K-pop sensation BTS's 'Butter' Official MV (37 lakh) and Johnny Depp v Amber Heard Defamation Trial (35 lakh).

Chandrayaan-3: India to celebrate August 23 as 'National Space Day'

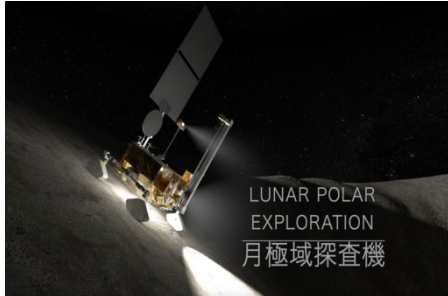
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** on August 26 announced to celebrate **August 23**, when India's Chandrayaan-3 landed on the Moon, as **National Space Day**.
- He also announced that the spot where the lander landed on the Moon will be known

as 'Shivashakti' and where Chandrayaan-2 touched down will be called as 'Tiranga Point'.

- The Prime Minister while addressing the scientists at the **ISRO Telemetry Tracking and Command Network Mission Control Complex** in Bengaluru said that experts suggest that in a few years, India's space industry will become \$16 billion from \$8 billion.

ISRO's next mission to Moon is with Japanese, named LUPE

- Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** is preparing for one more lunar mission, this one in collaboration with Japanese space agency, **The Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA)**.



- This mission, called **LUPEX, or Lunar Polar Exploration**, is slated for 2024-25. As its name suggests, LUPEX will explore the polar regions of the Moon, this time venturing into the permanently shaded regions.
- LUPEX is also planned to investigate the abundance of water in the polar regions, and explore the possibilities of locating a long-term station in these areas.

Anand Marriage (Sikh Marriage) Act in India

- In India, the **Anand Marriage (Sikh Marriage) Act** holds significant importance for the Sikh community. It is a legislation that specifically governs the marriage ceremonies and legal aspects related to **Sikh marriages**.

- Established in **2010**, **B20** is among the most **prominent Engagement groups in G20**. Comprising representatives from diverse companies and business organizations, the **B20's** primary

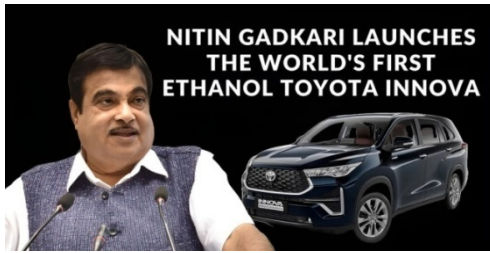


objective is to form actionable policy recommendations that stimulate economic growth and development.

This spacecraft is all set to journey towards the Sun in early September, with a launch date scheduled for **September 2**.
- The majestic event will take place at the **Sriharikota launch site** in Andhra Pradesh, India. This strategic location has witnessed numerous historic launches and is now primed to witness another significant milestone in space exploration—the launch of Aditya-L1.
- Aditya-L1 is designed to delve into the enigmatic layers surrounding the Sun, specifically the photosphere and chromosphere. To achieve this, the spacecraft is equipped with seven advanced payloads, each serving a unique purpose in the mission's quest to unravel the Sun's mysteries.

International

Russia-Africa Economic and Humanitarian Summits

- On July 27–28, 2023, St. Petersburg, Russia, hosted the **Second Summit of Russia–Africa Economic and Humanitarian Forum**, a momentous occasion that showcased the growing relations between Russia and the countries of the African continent.
- This summit marked the second time such events of this magnitude were held, indicating the significance and commitment of both parties towards fostering stronger ties and cooperation.
- The discussions during the summit were centered around the vision of jointly building a new, fairer multipolar **architecture for the world order**. Participants stressed the importance of a world order that upholds sovereign equality among states and promotes mutually beneficial cooperation.



Beijing Faces Historic Flooding as China Witnesses Highest Rainfall in 140 Years

- China's capital, **Beijing**, experienced a historic deluge, recording a staggering 744.8 millimeters of rainfall over the course of five days. This torrential downpour, the **highest in 140 years**, was triggered by the remnants of **Typhoon Doksuri**, leaving streets submerged and residents stranded.
- The disaster has resulted in tragic fatalities, with at least 21 people losing their lives and 26 others still reported missing. Beijing and the surrounding **province of Hebei** faced severe flooding, causing extensive damage to infrastructure and posing a significant challenge to rescue operations.



Pakistan Approves New Security Pact with the US, Signaling a Fresh Start in Defense Cooperation

- In a significant development, the federal cabinet of **Pakistan** has quietly approved the signing of a new security pact with the **United States**.
- The Communication Interoperability and Security Memorandum of Agreement (CIS-MOA) will pave the way for enhanced defense ties between the two nations and may allow Pakistan to procure **military hardware** from Washington DC.
- This move comes after the previous agreement, signed in 2005, expired in 2020.

Cambodian King appoints Hun Sen's son as new Prime Minister

- Cambodia's** King, Norodom Sihamoni issued a royal decree appointing **Hun Manet as Prime Minister**, after Mr. Hun Sen had announced last month that he was stepping down and handing power to his eldest son.
- Mr. Hun Sen, one of the world's longest-serving leaders made the announcement days after a landslide victory in July polls that were widely decried as a sham, after main challenger the Candlelight Party was barred from participating.
- Cambodia Capital: Phnom Penh, Cambodia Currency: Cambodian riel, Cambodia Official language: Khmer.



Iraq bans media from using term 'homosexuality'

- The media regulatory body of Iraq has issued a prohibition on the usage of the term **'homosexuality'** instructing both media and social media entities to employ the term **'sexual deviance'** in its place.
- This move comes after significant Iraqi factions have intensified their **opposition** to LGBT rights, frequently exemplified by the **burning of rainbow flags** in protests.



- This directive encompasses **all media and social media** establishments functioning within the country, as specified by the **Iraqi Communications and Media Commission (CMC)**.

Pakistan's Parliament Dissolved: Setting the Stage for National Election Amidst Crisis

- In a significant political development, **Pakistan's President** took the step of dissolving the country's parliament as per the recommendation of Prime Minister **Shehbaz Sharif**.
- The lower house of the Parliament's five-year term is due to end on August 12. This move comes at a critical juncture as Pakistan grapples with both political and economic challenges.
- The decision to dissolve the parliament was executed just three days prior to the culmination of the current parliamentary term. As part of the process, a caretaker administration will be established, jointly chosen by Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and a representative from the outgoing parliament's opposition leadership.

Cambodia: A Woman Parliament President For 1st Time In History

- In a move towards gender inclusivity and leadership diversity, **KhunSudary** is set to assume the esteemed role of **President** of the National Assembly of **Cambodia**.
- Currently serving as the **second Vice-President** of the National Assembly and a prominent member of the Standing Committee of the **Cambodian People's Party (CPP)**, KhunSudary's ascent to the presidency reflects her years of dedication and service to her nation.
- The announcement was made by Prime Minister **SamdechTecho Hun Sen**, emphasizing the commitment to empowering women in pivotal roles within the government.

Dutch Economy Enters Recession

- **The Dutch economy** has entered a recession, shrinking **0.3%** on a quarterly basis in the second quarter. This is the first recession since the pandemic, and follows a 0.4% contraction in the first three months of the year.



- The eurozone's fifth largest economy was driven by a drop in consumer spending and exports. Consumer spending fell 1.6%, while exports were 0.7% lower than in the first three months of the year.
- Inflation in the Netherlands has dropped since hitting a peak of 14.5% in September 2022, but was still relatively high at about 6% in the second quarter of 2023. The recession is expected to have a negative impact on employment, with the unemployment rate rising from 3.5% to 4% in the coming months.

Typhoon Lan Hits Japan, Causing Flooding and Power Outages

- **Typhoon Lan** made landfall in **Japan, August 15**, bringing heavy rain and strong winds. The typhoon has caused flooding and power outages in several areas, and authorities have issued evacuation warnings for some residents.



- The typhoon made landfall near Shionomisaki in Wakayama prefecture, about 400 kilometers southwest of Tokyo. It had maximum sustained winds of 160 kilometers per hour (100 miles per hour), equivalent to a Category 2 hurricane.
- Typhoon Lan has caused widespread damage in Japan. The typhoon has caused flooding and landslides, and has knocked down trees and power lines. More than 237,000 people have been evacuated from their homes, and more than 100,000 households are without power.

'Pibot,' the humanoid robot that can safely pilot an airplane

- The **Korea Advanced Institute of Science & Technology (KAIST)** is making groundbreaking advancements in aviation with the development of "**Pibot**," a humanoid robot designed to fly aircraft using its own dexterity and advanced AI capabilities.
- Pibot harnesses the power of artificial intelligence to comprehend and retain intricate flight manuals



presented in everyday language. It surpasses human pilots by effortlessly memorizing extensive sets of Jeppesen aeronautical navigation charts, an accomplishment beyond human capabilities.

- Pibot's remarkable memory and adaptability empower it to navigate diverse aircraft models without the need for emulating human pilot behaviors. Its impressive flexibility allows it to seamlessly transition between various aircraft configurations.
- Pibot's ability to manipulate flight instruments, understand complex manuals, and react quickly to emergency situations showcases its potential to transform aviation and other industries.

Russian e-visa facility for Indians

- **Russia** has launched an **e-visa facility for Indians** from August 1, allowing travellers to the country to surpass the hassles of obtaining a regular visa. The e-visa facility, also available for travellers from 54



other countries, does not require a visit to consulates or embassies.

- One can apply for an e-visa online through the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia. The application must be submitted at least 40 days and no later than 4 days before the planned trip.
- You will need to provide a digital photo and a scan of the information page of your passport. The e-visa is valid for 60 days from the date of issue and allows you to stay in Russia for up to 16 days. The cost of the e-visa is 35 USD.

System called

PM conferred LokmanyaTilak National Award in Pune

- The LokmanyaTilak National Award was granted to the Prime Minister of India, ShriNarendraModi, in Pune, Maharashtra, during a ceremony that commemorated the 103rd death anniversary of LokmanyaTilak.
- The prestigious award, instituted by the Tilak SmarakMandir Trust in 1983, aims to honor the lasting legacy of LokmanyaTilak. ShriNarendraModi became the 41st distinguished individual to receive this esteemed recognition.
- The previous year saw the presentation of the LokmanyaTilak National Award to Tessa Thomas, a renowned senior scientist often referred to as India's "missile woman."



Ratan Tata conferred with Maharashtra govt.'s 'UdyogRatna' award

- Eminent industrialist Ratan Tata was conferred with the first ever 'UdyogRatna' award instituted by the Maharashtra government. The award was presented to the 85-year-old chairman emeritus of Tata Sons by Chief Minister EknathShinde and Deputy Chief Ministers DevendraFadnavis and AjitPawar at the industrialist's home in Colaba in south Mumbai.
- The Tata group operates in more than 100 countries across six continents. In 2021-22, the collective revenue of Tata companies stood at \$128 billion. The honour comprised a shawl, a citation and a memento from the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC).



- The UdyogRatna award is a prestigious award that recognizes the achievements of outstanding industrialists in Maharashtra. It is a testament to the contribution of these individuals to the economic development of the state.

PM Modi honoured with Greece's Grand Cross of the Order of Honour

- Prime Minister NarendraModi was conferred with the Grand Cross of the Order of Honour by Greek President Katerina N. Sakellaropoulou in Athens. The award is the highest civilian honour that can be bestowed by Greece to a foreign head of government.

F1 defending champion Max Verstappen wins Belgian Grand Prix

Defending Formula One champion **Max Verstappen** emphatically won the **Belgian Grand Prix** for an eighth straight win and 10th overall of a crushingly dominant season. He finished 22.3 seconds ahead of teammate **Sergio Perez** to give Red Bull and easy 1-2. It moved Verstappen ominously closer to a third straight world title and his own F1 record of 15 wins from last year.

- **AishwaryPratap Singh Tomar**, along with compound archers AvneetKaur, Sangampreet Singh Bisla, and the men's 10m air rifle team, achieved



remarkable victories by securing gold medals at the **FISU World University Games 2023** in Chengdu, the People's Republic of China.

- With these achievements, India's medal tally at the FISU World University Games 2023 reached an impressive total of **17 medals** – nine gold, three silver, and five bronze.
- India currently holds the **fourth position** on the medals table, trailing behind China, Japan, and the Republic of Korea.

Moeen Ali confirms his Retirement from Test Cricket after Ashes 2023

- England all-rounder **Moeen Ali** confirms his test cricket retirement after the end of the Ashes series and he will play in other formats of cricket. On the request of England Test captain BenStokes, he played the Ashes series. But he retired from test cricket in September 2021.
- He played for England in 68 test matches taking 204 wickets and scored 3094 runs. He was awarded the Order of the British Empire(OBE) in June 2023 for his services to cricket.



GM Gukesh overtakes ViswanathanAnand to become highest Indian in FIDE rankings

- The 17-year-old chess prodigy, **D. Gukesh**, has dethroned Grandmaster **ViswanathanAnand** as India's top-ranked chess player in the live world rankings.
- Gukesh achieved this feat by defeating MistradinIskandarov in the second round of the FIDE World Cup, reaching a live rating of **2755.9** and climbing to the 9th position in the classic open category. In contrast, Anand's rating of 2754.0 caused him to drop to the 10th spot. This is only the second time since 1986 that Anand has been displaced from the top position.

World Archery Championships 2023: India wins historic gold medal

- The Indian women's compound archery team etched their names in history by clinching a gold medal at the **World Archery Championships** held in Berlin, Germany. This



victory marked India's first-ever gold at the archery world championships in any category.

- It was India's first-ever gold at the archery world championships in any category. The triumphant team comprised **JyothiSurekhaVennam, ParneetKaur, and AditiGopichand Swami**.
- In the final round, they showcased an exceptional performance against the Mexican team, consisting of Dafne Quintero, Ana Sofia Hernandez Jeon, and Andrea Becerra. The Indian trio emerged victorious with a score of 235-229, demonstrating their prowess and precision in the sport.

FISU World University Games 2023, Complete Medal Tally

- The **31st** installment of the **World University Games**, previously known as the Universiade, is currently taking place in Chengdu, People's Republic of China, from **July 28th to August 8th, 2023**.

- This prestigious event brings together over 9,500 talented student-athletes from universities around the world, competing in 18 different sports, and vying for a total of 269 medals.
- Originally slated for 2021, the World University Games had to be rescheduled twice due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The previous edition, held in Naples in 2019, saw Japan emerge as the dominant nation, securing the highest position on the medal table. Japan clinched an impressive total of 82 medals, which included 33 gold, 21 silver, and 28 bronze.

Neymar Jr Quits PSG To Sign For Saudi Arabia's Al-Hilal

- Brazil forward **Neymar Jr** has signed for Saudi Arabia's **Al-Hilal** from **Paris Saint-Germain (PSG)**, the clubs announced, joining Cristiano Ronaldo and Karim Benzema. Neymar, 31, scored 118 goals in 173 matches for PSG in six injury-plagued seasons.
- He won five Ligue 1 titles and three French Cups, but was on the losing side as PSG were beaten by Bayern Munich in the 2020 Champions League final.

Dutee Chand gets four-year ban for failing dope test

- Indian sprinter **Dutee Chand**, renowned as India's fastest female athlete and holder of the national 100m record, has been handed a significant blow with a four-year ban following her failure in an out-of-competition dope test.
- The test revealed the presence of **selective androgen receptor modulators (SARMs)**, leading to the decision to suspend her from competitive sports.
- Chand's ban, which commences from January 3, 2023, stems from her failed out-of-competition dope test for SARMs, which occurred on December 5, 2022. As a consequence of her violation, all competitive outcomes she achieved from the date of sample collection will be annulled.



FIFA Women's World Cup 2023: Spain wins the title with 1-0 victory over England

- Spain** secured their first ever **Women's World Cup** title with a 1-0 win over **England** at the **2023 FIFA Women's World Cup final** in Sydney. The win marks a



historic FIFA Women's World Cup campaign for Spain who previously failed to make it past the Round of 16.

- Making it to the final after knockout wins over Switzerland, the Netherlands and Sweden, was already a first for Spain with the victory in the final cause for an even bigger celebration. **Captain Olga Carmona** smashed the decisive goal as Spain defeated England 1-0 to lift the FIFA Women's World Cup title.

- Competing in the **76 kg** category, **Priya Malik** showcased her prowess on the mat. In the gold medal match, she triumphed over **Germany's Laura Kuehn** with a resounding score of 5-0.
- **Priya Malik's** victory makes her only the **second Indian woman** to attain a gold medal in the prestigious **U20 World Wrestling Championships**. She joins the ranks of **Antim Panghal**, another Indian wrestler who had previously secured a gold medal in the same competition.

Wrestling Federation of India membership suspended on world stage

- The **Wrestling Federation of India (WFI)**, India's governing body for wrestling, has faced suspension from the **United World Wrestling (UWW)** due to ongoing controversies and prolonged delays in conducting essential elections.
- The WFI's scheduled elections, initially set for June 2023, have been repeatedly postponed due to protests by Indian wrestlers and legal challenges from various state units. This delay prompted the UWW, the global authority for wrestling, to suspend the WFI's membership. The suspension comes as a result of the federation's failure to meet the required election timeline.
- As a consequence of this suspension, Indian wrestlers will be unable to compete under the Indian flag in the upcoming World Championships. Instead, they will participate as 'neutral athletes' in the Olympic-qualifying World Championships.



Chess World Cup 2023 Final: India's Praggnanandhaa finishes 2nd

- **Rameshbabu Praggnanandhaa** finished **second in FIDE World Cup**. After three days and four games of intensely nery chess across two formats, **Magnus Carlsen** finally managed to win the **FIDE World Cup** for the first time in his career.
- **Carlsen** defeated **Praggnanandhaa** in the final, but not before the 18-year-old teenage had dragged him

through the tie-breaker. Carlsen's win was confirmed after the second game of the tiebreaker. The two players had played out one draw each.

- Pragganandha, who turned 18 during the World Cup, was the youngest World Cup finalist ever, and is the youngest World Cup winner. Seeded 31, Pragg is also the lowest seed to make the final of the World Cup.

Max Verstappen wins Dutch Grand Prix 2023

- **Max Verstappen** has won the **Dutch Grand Prix** for the third consecutive year, once again prevailing at his home race. With the dominant win, Verstappen has now matched Sebastian Vettel's all-time record of nine F1 victories in a row.
- Verstappen's victory was his 11th of the season, and it extended his lead in the Drivers' Championship to 138 points. He is now on course to win his second consecutive World Championship.

- **Neeraj Chopra** made history by winning the gold medal in the men's javelin throw event at the **World Athletics Championships** held in **Budapest, Hungary**. He became the first-ever Indian athlete to achieve this feat, marking a significant milestone for Indian athletics.
- Neeraj's exceptional performance was highlighted by a remarkable throw of **88.17 meters** during his second attempt. This outstanding achievement showcased his skill and dominance in the event, solidifying his position as a global contender.
- Pakistan's **Arshad Nadeem**, the reigning Commonwealth Games champion, took the silver with



a season's best of 87.82m while the Czech Republic's Jakub Vadlejch won bronze with 86.67m. The other two Indian athletes in the 12-man javelin throw finals at Budapest also logged impressive results. **Kishore Jena** finished fifth with a personal best haul of 84.77m while **DP Manu** was sixth with 84.14m.

HS Prannoy Clinches Bronze At BWF World Badminton Championships 2023

- Indian badminton player **HS Prannoy** secured the **bronze medal** in the men's singles category at the prestigious **BWF World Badminton Championships 2023**. Prannoy faced elimination during the semi-finals against Thailand's Kunlavut Vitidsarn in a match held in Copenhagen, Denmark.
- The 31-year-old HS Prannoy etched his name in Indian badminton history by becoming only the **fifth Indian men's singles player** to clinch a medal at the BWF World Badminton Championships. Among his compatriots, **Kidambi Srikanth** remains the sole player to reach the men's singles final, achieving this feat in 2021.

Telangana folk singer Gaddar passes away

- Renowned folk singer and activist **Gaddar**, who had been battling severe heart disease, passed away at the age of 74.
- Gaddar, also known as **GummadiVittalRao**, gained popularity primarily through his stage name. He earned the title of the **people's singer** due to his songs that brought attention to various issues faced by the common people.

Renowned nuclear physicist BikashSinha passes away

- Renowned nuclear physicist **BikashSinha** has passed away at the age of 78, was suffering from old age-related ailments. A recipient of **Padma Shri in 2001 and Padma Bhusan in 2010**, he was the former director of the Saha Institute of Nuclear Physics and Variable Energy Cyclotron Centre.
- Sinha specialized in nuclear physics, high energy physics, Quark Gluon Plasma and early universe cosmology. He led the Indian team for the first time to participate in the experiments at the European Organization for Nuclear Research in Geneva.



Former India football captain Mohammed Habib passes away

- Former India captain and legendary footballer **Mohammed Habib** passed away. He represented India in many international tournaments from 1965-76. He was considered by many experts as one of the best players the country has ever produced.
- Born in Hyderabad in undivided Andhra Pradesh on July 17, 1949, Habib represented India for a decade from 1965-75 and was part of the golden generation that won a bronze medal in the 1970 Asian Games in Bangkok.
- For 17 long seasons starting from 1966-77, Habib, despite his diminutive nature, was a stalwart walking



on the football grounds in Kolkata, according to former India captain and Hyderabadadi Victor Amalraj.

British 'chat show king' Michael Parkinson passes away at 88

- **Michael Parkinson**, the seasoned **British chat show host** renowned for his conversations with notable personalities, has **passed away** at the age of 88. His family said that he peacefully departed at his residence after a brief period of illness
- Hailing from the coalmining village of **Cudworth** in northern **England**, Michael Parkinson hosted his talk show named '**Parkinson**' in June 1971, captivating viewers with his distinctive interview approach, characterized by his amiable charm. The show enjoyed a prosperous run **until 1982**, later making a comeback in 1998, further solidifying Parkinson's status as a true chat show maestro.
- Parkinson's contributions to the world of media and entertainment were duly recognized when he was **knighthooded** by **Queen Elizabeth II** at Buckingham Palace in **2008**. The honor bestowed upon him was a testament to his enduring influence on British culture. In **2005**, he assumed the role of **president** for the **Sports Journalists' Association** of Great Britain.



Adobe Co-Founder Dr. John Warnock Passes Away at 82

- Adobe co-founder **Dr. John Warnock** passed away at the age of 82.
- He founded the revolutionary software company Adobe with his partner, the now-late Dr. Charles Geschke, in 1982. Marva Warnock designed the company's original logo, and Adobe released its first program, the desktop publishing software Adobe PostScript, two years later.
- Warnock served mostly as the company's CEO until 2000 and was co-chairman of the board along with



Geschke until 2017. Warnock remained on the company board of directors afterward. During Warnock's tenure as its CEO, Adobe created industry-standard software for business, graphic design, photography, video editing, audio recording, and more.

Legendary statistical scientist CR Rao passes away at the age of 103

- **C Radhakrishna Rao**, one of India's greatest mathematicians and statisticians of India, passes away at the age of 103. He had recently received the prestigious "**International Prize in Statistics-2023**", often referred to as the "statistics' equivalent of the Nobel Prize".
- C R Rao was born into a Telugu family in Ballari, which was part of the **Madras Presidency and is now in Karnataka**. In 1941, he completed his MSc in Mathematics from Andhra University and joined Indian Statistical Institute in Calcutta in 1943 as research scholar.
- In 2020, the **Department of Science and Technology (DST)** of the Indian government conferred a felicitation to **C R Rao**, when he turned 100 in an online symposium for his "path-breaking contributions in the field of statistics, for recognising and facilitating the critical role of data and computing. Recognising his contributions, he was honoured with the Padma Bhushan award in 1968 and the Padma Vibhushan award in 2001. In 2023 he was awarded with International Prize in Statistics.

'RIP superstar,' tributes pour in for WWE Superstar Bray Wyatt

- **Windham Rotunda**, also known as **Bray Wyatt**, passed away at age 36. Rotunda was an American professional wrestler. He was best known for his tenure in WWE, where he performed under the ring name Bray Wyatt.
- **Windham Lawrence Rotunda** was born in Brooksville, Florida, on May 23, 1987. He attended Hernando High School, where he won a state wrestling championship at 275 pounds (125 kg) in 2005. He graduated in 2005.



- Wyatt had started his career way back in 2010 under the ring name Husky Harris. However, he would quickly undergo a gimmick change and become the leader of the Wyatt Family, which received a lot of fame and praise from the fans. Wyatt would undergo multiple character changes during his time in WWE with his character as The Fiend, once again capturing the imagination of the fans. After being released from the company in 2021, Wyatt came back to WWE in 2022 and his final match took place at Royal Rumble 2023 against LA Knight.

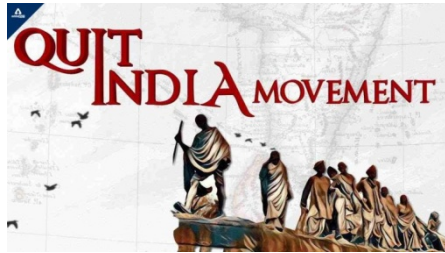
World Nagasaki Day 2023: Date, Significance and History
